

HOUSE RULES AERIE 4308

Revised January 2017

1. All house rules must conform to county, state and federal regulations. All members' behavior must conform to the house rules and to the standards of common decency.
2. Fighting, abusive language or abusive behavior will not be permitted.
3. The house rules consider auxiliary members as full Members. Both aerie and auxiliary members are responsible for the proper dress and behavior of their guests.
4. All guests must be signed into the aerie, by a member in good standing. Non-members are not allowed in the aerie unless signed in. A bona fide guest is someone who has been invited by a member before the event and is known by the member.
5. Adult guests must leave with the member that signed them in. Minors must leave with the member who signed them in.
6. No alcoholic beverages in or out the front door. Only in designated areas, in the club or on the patio, but not in the meeting room or library area
7. No minors allowed in social room unless with a parent, spouse or legal guardian. No minors allowed at the bar or on the raise area around the bar, or the round tables by the TV. The social room shall be designated as from the folding doors north to the end of the building. The hall or ballroom shall be designated as from the folding doors south to the end of the building. No minors under 14 years of age allowed on pool tables unless supervised by a parent or legal guardian. No 12 year old minors in social room after 9:00 pm.
8. No drinking allowed in the parking lot. No drugs are allowed on eagle property. No behavior on eagle property that will disturb the neighbors?
9. There will be no drinking after 2:00 am Monday thru Saturday. No drinking before noon on Sundays or after Midnight on Sundays.
10. No drinking by anyone obviously drunk.
11. No drinking by a bartender. Bartenders must be an adult. No one behind the bar without the bartenders'^ permission, with exception for the club manager, auditor or trustees
12. No discrimination because of race, religion or sex.
13. No firearms, loaded or unloaded, allowed in building. No animals allowed in the building, unless it is a service dog. No knives with bladed over four inches long in building, except in the kitchen area.
14. The bartender may ask anyone to leave the property for any indecency, but only for a period of up to the next trustee meeting. The trustee's may suspend that person for up to 90 days. That person may appeal to the trial committee.
15. All authorized visitors, or previously dropped members, may visit the social room 2 times in any 3 month period and then on the third time must apply for membership. This rule applies to all persons eligible to apply for membership and live within the area of the aerie. That area is defined as a radius of 25 miles. Excluding aerie spouses and auxiliary spouses.
16. There shall be no personal gambling in the aerie proper. Personal gambling in defined as side bets on sports events, pools, and any other betting in lieu of pull tabs or gaming machines, excluding pool or similar tournaments.

- 1) **The previous line 5** (5. Any aerie member that has been dropped from the roster will not be allowed to be signed in as a guest. They must re-enroll and pay the proper fees. After a one year absence any member who has been dropped from the membership rolls because they have moved out of the area may be signed in as a guest two times in a three month period. **Was deleted**)
- 2) Line 16 changed to include (or previously dropped members)
 - (ie) All authorized visitors, *or previously dropped members*, may visit the social room 2 times in any 3 month period and then on the third time must apply for membership. This rule applies to all persons eligible to apply for membership and live within the area of the aerie. That area is defined as a radius of 25 miles. Excluding aerie spouses and auxiliary spouses.
